FOREWORD

This exhibition of drawings shows the work of 79 individual American artists done in the 20th century. Each artist being represented by one work only.

Although the exhibition as a whole cannot be considered a complete survey of the various types of works created by artists during this period, examples are to be found presenting certain fundamental changes regarding basic creative concepts that have occurred during the 20th century. The foremost of these being the contemporary artist's interest in projecting the subject of the work in highly expressionistic or non-objective terms.

As the works included in the exhibitions cover a period of approximately 65 years the artists who created them can be divided into three separate categories these being as follows:

1. Artists born during the latter half of the 19th century who continued producing works during various periods of the 20th. This group is represented by 46 of the drawings to be found in the exhibition.

2. Artists born during the first quarter of the 20th century, the very large majority of these are still living and are represented by 27 works.

3. Artists born during the second quarter of the present century, this group being represented by 6 drawings.












