

Foreword

THE PRESENT EXHIBITION is devoted to works of art in which animals are the single subject of the work or a factor included in the composition as a whole. It numbers 174 original items the greater portion of these being works created by artists of the 20th Century. In addition, various items are included by Egyptian, Hindu, Chinese, Japanese, Peruvian and Mexican artists of earlier times: Prints of the 15th, 16th, 17th, 18th, and 19th centuries by English, Dutch, French, and Spanish artists: and works in a variety of mediums by artists of the Bambara, Dahomey, Baule and Senufo Tribes of Negro Africa.

The great mass of works devoted to this subject matter over the past centuries belongs to either of two greatly contrasted categories. Those that are the product of a culture in which Mythology was a dominant factor and certain animals were believed to possess supernatural powers either helpful or destructive to man; and those in which Mythological concepts of man's relationship to his environment ceased to exist. In the former, great liberties were taken by the artist and the animal being portrayed is often hardly recognizable as such; in the latter the physical as well as other characteristics of the animal are fully realized. Regardless of the particular category to which individual works belong, masterpieces abound in both.

The reproductions in this catalogue, placed two on the same page, were chosen for the purpose of presenting strongly contrasted works as regards conception and execution.

The reasons for these contrasts vary: in certain instances it is due to the particular periods to which each work belongs; in others, because of the strong contrast between the creative temperaments of the individual artists: and finally it can be a combination of both. Regardless of the factors involved, the placement of the reproductions makes for highly interesting comparisons and the same plan has been used as often as possible, in hanging the works in the various galleries; thereby adding a significant aspect to the exhibition as a whole.


BARYE — 1795-1875 — GREYHOUND RETRIEVING A RABBIT — BRONZE
















HART — 1868-1933 — PIG MARKET — SOFT GROUND ETCHING


DURCHANEK — CONTEMPORARY — MARDI GRAS


CURRY — 1897-1946 — HOUNDS AND COYOTE — LITHOGRAPH
